

**Alaska Weeds of Concern**  
**list for weed-free certification standards**  
**2020**

During the certification process, the plants on the Alaska Weeds of Concern list are surveyed for **in addition to** the nationally recognized North American Invasive Species Management Association's (NAISMA) Noxious Weed List. In order to have products certified as weed-free, no propagative parts of any of these listed species may be present.

**Forage**

- Hempnettle (*Galeopsis* spp.)
- Bird vetch (*Vicia cracca*)
- Black bindweed/wild buckwheat (*Polygonum convolvulus*)
- Hawkbit/fall dandelion (*Leontodon autumnalis*)
- Narrowleaf hawkweed (*Hieracium umbellatum*)
- Corn spurry (*Spergula arvensis*)

**Gravel**

- White sweetclover (*Melilotus alba*)
- Narrowleaf hawkweed (*Hieracium umbellatum*)
- Reed canarygrass (*Phalaris arundinacea*)
- Japanese knotweed (*Polygonum cuspidatum*)
- Bird vetch (*Vicia cracca*)
- Hawkbit/fall dandelion (*Leontodon autumnalis*)
- Hempnettle (*Galeopsis* spp.)
- Black bindweed/wild buckwheat (*Polygonum convolvulus*)
- Bohemian Knotweed (*Polygonum sachalinense*)
- Giant Knotweed (*Polygonum x bohemicum*)
